Woodward, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second from Little Butter Creek for irrigation of a certain 3.5 acres in NE4 SW4 and 7.0 acres in SE4 SW4 of Section 12; and 9.5 acres in NE4 NW4 of Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 28 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1872.
