IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF RALPH WINNIFORD FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER FROM CALAPOOYA CREEK

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3480

On October 13, 1976, Ralph Winniford filed an application for transfer of water right in the office of the Water Resources Director proposing a change in place of use under an existing right of record as described by the certificate recorded at Page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ralph Winniford which includes the use of not to exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second from Calapooya Creek for irrigation of 11.4 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 10.5 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, Section 28, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 4, 1957.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 540 feet South and 520 feet West from the Northeast corner of Barrett D.L.C. #54, being within the SW2 SE2 of Section 29, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use and sever the right therefrom and to irrigate a certain 18.9 acres in SW2 SW2 of Section 28, 0.2 acre in SE2 SE2 of Section 29, and 2.8 acres in NW2 NW2 of Section 33, Township 25 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster of District No. 15, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights. No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

> That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Ralph Winniford and recorded at Page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Ralph Winniford.

under Permit No. 24886 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion,  $SW_4$  SE4, as projected within Barrett DLC 54, Section 29, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M., 540 feet South and 520 feet West from the NE Corner, Barrett DLC 54

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4$  SW4, as projected within C. Grover DLC 43, Section 28, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M., 1125 feet North and 825 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 21.9 acres SW4 SW4 Section 28 as projected within C. Grover DLC 43 T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered October 25, 1976, and June 8, 1979, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 43957, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 29486, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
