

On November 3, 1976, Brooks Resources Corporation filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Dry Creek pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of E. A. Greham, describes an existing right of record for the use of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second from Dry Creek for irrigation of 20.0 acres in NET NET, 20.0 acres in NET and 10.0 acres in NET NWT, Section 22, Township 14 South, Range 9 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1880.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 140 feet South and 1750 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 22, being within the NET NWT of Section 22, Township 14 South, Range 9 East, W.M.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.
