

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 26590, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Wilhelm and Rosa Mullerleile, describes an existing right of record which includes the use of not to exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream and reservoir for irrigation of 16.4 acres in NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 10.0 acres in SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ and 0.2 acre in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 2, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 27, 1951.
