Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Irvin R. Phifer, describes an existing right of record for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream for domestic use for two families, being one residence in NET NWT and one residence in Lot 6 (NWT NWT), Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 12, 1966.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 4500 feet
North and 3180 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 36, being
within the NET NWT of Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use from the one family residence in NE¹ NW¹ to a new one family residence in Lot 6 (NW¹ NW¹) of Section 36, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W.M.

Mr. Ben Monroe, Watermaster of District No. 18, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights. No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Irvin R. Phifer and recorded at Page 43270, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Irvin R. Phifer.
