



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3489

On November 8, 1976, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John F. Walchli for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River and an unnamed stream under existing rights of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered September 9, 1916, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Umatilla River and Its Tributaries, a water right tabulated at page 233, Volume 3, was allowed in the name of Furnish Ditch Company (now Stanfield Irrigation District) for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 40.0 acres in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 8, 1905. These lands also have a supplemental right under permit No. 7400 to the use of water stored in McKay Reservoir with a date of priority of July 1, 1924.

The certificate recorded at page 38998, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John F. Walchli, describes a right which includes the use of water from an unnamed stream for supplemental irrigation of a certain 11.5 acres of said lands in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., with a date of priority of January 21, 1965.

Water for this right is diverted from a point located 1040 feet North and 1540 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 4, being within the SW¹₄ NE¹₄ of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof by the use of water from Umatilla River a certain 25.2 acres in SW4 NE4, 3.6 acres in SE4 NE4 and 11.2 acres in NE4 SE4 of Section 9, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., and to irrigate in lieu thereof by the use of the supplemental supply of water from the unnamed stream the westerly 11.5 acres of said 25.2 acres in SW4 SE4 of Section 9, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Stanfield Irri-

Special Order Record Volume 32, page 116 gation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held June 14, 1976.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use of water, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water from Umatilla River to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Stanfield Irrigation District, or their successor in interest, at the time certificates are issued confirming rights allowed in the Umatilla River Adjudication proceedings.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 1979, provided for cancellation of a portion of the right described by certificate of water right recorded at page 38998, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water from the unnamed stream to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore recorded at page 38998, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein confirming the change authorized herein and covering the balance of the right NOT canceled.

ORDER

On June 8, 1978, John Walchli submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 38998, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John F. Walchli, and is for the use of water from an unnamed stream, with a date of priority of January 21, 1965, for the supplemental irrigation of 27.1 acres in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 38998, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

This Is to Certify, That JOHN F. WALCHLI

of Route 3, Box 342, Hermiston , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 341.4 acres and supplemental irrigation of 303.0 acres

under Permit No. 30373 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.14 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 NE2, Section 4, T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W. M., 1040 feet North and 1540 feet West from E2 Corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
