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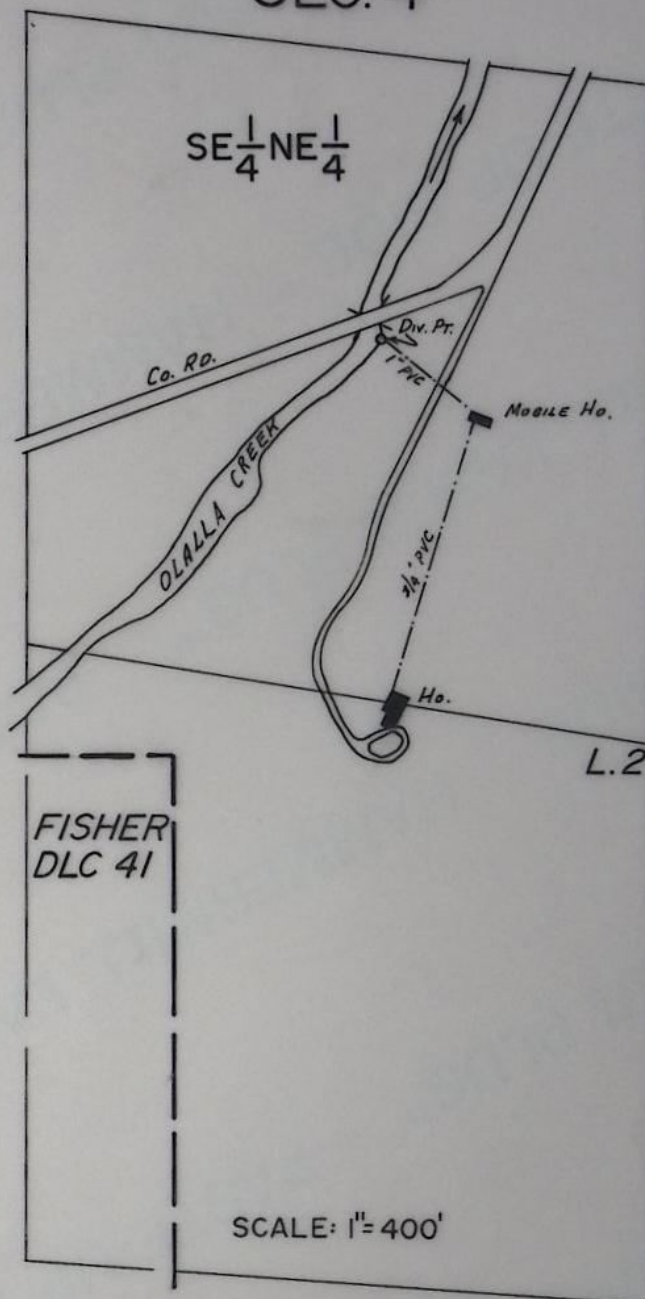

of Star Route, Box 62, Winston, State of Oregon 97496, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Olalla Creek a tributary of Tenmile Creek for the purpose of Supplemental Domestic use for two families under Permit No. 19875 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 1, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4, Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W. M. ; 850' N. & 420' E. from the easterly NE Corner Fisher DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

On January 11, 1977, Dale L. Bowman filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in use heretofore made under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 22497, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Douglas W. and Charlotte L. Parazoo describes an existing right of record which includes the use of not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from Olalla Creek for irrigation of 0.4 acre in Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 3, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 4, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 675 feet North and 675 feet West from the East quarter-corner of Section 4, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the use heretofore made and to use the water for supplemental domestic supply for two one-family residences in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of February 1, 8 and 15, 1977.



Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in use of water heretofore made from Olalla Creek from irrigation to supplemental domestic use during the irrigation season of each year described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Douglas W. and Charlotte L. Parazoo and recorded at Page 22497, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
