#### CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DARRELL AND LUELLA FRIEND P.O. BOX 41 ASHWOOD, OREGON 97711

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 51.0 ACRES.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JEFFERSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at page 57. The date of priority is 1891 FOR TRACTS 1 AND 2 AND MARCH 1898 FOR TRACT 3.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(1) [EAST DITCH (FRIEND 1)] SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 25; (2) [EAST DITCH] NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 9 S, R 16 E, W.M.; DIVERSION 1 - 200 FEET SOUTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 24; DIVERSION 2 - 650 FEET NORTH AND 300 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1.5 ACRE-FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY PERIOD OF 30 DAYS OR 6.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

THE QUANTITY OF WATER DIVERTED AT THE NEW POINTS OF DIVERSION, TOGETHER WITH THAT DIVERTED AT THE ORIGINAL POINTS OF DIVERSION, SHALL NOT EXCEED THE QUANTITY OF WATER AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINTS OF DIVERSION.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINTS OF DIVERSION AND AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 11, 1978, and together with Transfer 3690, supersedes Certificate 2234, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jefferson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the PATER WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume Tr at ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1691 for 57 page Tracts 1 and 2 and March 1898 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose S, and shall not exceed 1.50 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days or 6 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1: 1.5 acres in the NW MD; 4.1 acres in the SW ME; 8 acres in the NE NW; 4.6 acres in the SE NW; 6 Dacres in the NE SW; 1.1 acres in the SE SW; 5 acres in the NW EE; and 0.1 acre in the SW SE; of Section 25 and 10 acres in the SE SW; of Section 24, T 9 S. ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3509

On January 13, 1976, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Darrell Friend for approval of changes in points of diversion from Trout Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 2234, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Mrs. C. Friend, describes certain rights allowed by Decree of the Court in the Trout Creek adjudication, which include:

(a) Irrigation of, among other lands, 10.0 acres in SE<sup>4</sup> SW<sup>4</sup> of Section 24; 1.5 acres in NW<sup>4</sup> NE<sup>4</sup>, 8.0 acres in NE<sup>4</sup> NW<sup>4</sup> and 1.0 acre in SE<sup>4</sup> NW<sup>4</sup> of Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 16 East, W.M., under a date of priority of 1891, by diversion through the West Ditch (Friend No. 3), from a point of diversion located 1800 feet South and 50 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the SW<sup>4</sup> NE<sup>4</sup> of said Section 25;

(b) Irrigation of 7.7 acres in NW4 NE4, 6.3 acres in SW4 NE4 and 1.9 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 16 East, W.M., under a priority date of 1891, by diversion through the East Ditch (Friend No. 1), from a point of diversion located 650 feet North and 300 feet East from the South Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the SW4 SE4 of said Section 25;

(c) Irrigation of 10.7 acres in NE¼ SW¼, 3.1 acres in SE¼ SW¼, 0.1 acre in NW¼ SE¼ and 0.7 acre in SW¼ SE¼ of Section 24, Township 9 South, Range 16 East, W.M., under a date of priority of March, 1898, by diversion through the Maupin Ditch (Friend No. 2), from a point of diversion located 900 feet South and 200 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the NW¼ NE¼ of said Section 25.

The applicant proposes to make the following changes in point of diversion, without loss of priority:

(aa) With reference to the 6.3 acres in  $SW_4$  NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and 1.9 acres in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 25, as described in paragraph (b) above: continue to divert water through the East Ditch from the said point of diversion until June of each year

and to establish an additional point of diversion (pump No. 2) at a point located 450 feet South and 80 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the  $NW_4^1$  NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 25, for irrigation of said lands after the first of June of each year, all with a priority date of 1891;

(bb) With reference to the 7.7 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 25, described in paragraph (b) above; the 10.0 acres in SE4 SW4 of Section 24; 1.5 acres in NW4 NE4, 8.0 acres in NE4 NW4 and 1.0 acre in SE4 NW4 of Section 25, as described in paragraph (a) above, all with a priority date of 1891; and with reference to the 0.7 acre in SW4 SE4 and 3.1 acres in SE4 SW4 of Section 24, as described in paragraph (c) above, under a priority date of March, 1898: change from the points of diversion described in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) above, to irrigate these lands from pump No. 2, located 450 feet South and 80 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 25;

(cc) With reference to the 10.7 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and 0.1 acre in NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 24, as described in paragraph (c) above, with a priority date of March, 1898: change from the point of diversion described in paragraph (c) above, to irrigate this land from pump No. 1, located 120 feet South and 950 feet West from the Center of Section 24, being within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 24.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Madras Pioneer, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jefferson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 2, 9 and 16, 1978.

Mr. Bruce A. Estes, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed additional point of diversion and changes in points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed additional point of diversion may be established and the changes in points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested additional point of diversion and changes in points of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates

## and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the additional point of diversion established and the changes in points of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

The order approving transfer No. 3690 provided for the cancellation of said certificate of water right recorded at page 2234, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in that proceeding; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO new certificate of water right be issued covering the balance of the right as provided in the order approving transfer No. 3690; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

IF NO OB-JECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATION MAY BE AP-PROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING. Instructions regarding the filing of a protest will be furnished by the Water Resources Department upon request.
