CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KENNETH V. AND KATHLEEN G. KRUSE
GENERAL DELIVERY
FORT ROCK, OR 97735

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the BUCK CREEK BASIN for THE IRRIGATION OF 9.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-472. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 26 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 1120 FEET SOUTH AND 1500 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 9.8 ACRES

SECTION 12

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 25, 1977, and together with Certificate 68716, supersedes Certificate 27978, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3510

On January 20, 1977, Kenneth V. and Kathleen G. Kruse filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in place of use of groundwater pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

Certificate of water right recorded at page 27978, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Bub Baert, describes an existing right of record which includes the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second from a well for irrigation of 9.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, W.M., with a date of priority of August 18, 1952.

Water for the said right is diverted from a well located 1120 feet South and 1500 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 12, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 26 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes, without loss of priority, to sever the right therefrom and in lieu thereof to irrigate a certain 9.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12.

Mr. Howard L. Daggett, Watermaster of District No. 12, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed

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change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHERED ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Bud Baert and recorded at page 27978, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.

This Is to Certify, That BUD BAERT

of **Fort Rock**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of one well a tributary of **Buck Creek** for the purpose of irrigation of **58.8 acres**

under Permit No. **U-472** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 18, 1952**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.74 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 12, T. 26 S., R. 14 E., W.M. Well is **S. 17.1 chs. and W. 22.8 chs.** from N.E. corner Section 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
