ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3512

On January 31, 1977, Lloyd Rogers filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in place of use and point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of H. S. Perry describes an existing right of record for the use of water from Lone Rock Creek for irrigation of 6.2 acres in NW1 SW1, 0.8 acre in SW1 SW2 and 2.2 acres in SE1 SW2 of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 24 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 430 feet North and 860 feet West from the South quarter-corner of Section 31, being within the SE2 SW2 of said Section 31.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use and point of diversion and in lieu thereof, irrigate a certain 2.8 acres in NE1 SW1 and 6.4 acres in NW1 SW1 of Section 31, from a point of diversion located 1650 feet North and 1650 feet West from the South quarter-corner of Section 31, being within the NW1 SW2 of said Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 24 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Gilliam-Wheeler Times-Journal, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Gilliam County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of February 17 and 24, and March 3, 1977.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion from Lone Rock Creek described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made, and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to H. S. Perry and recorded at Page 25682, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
