

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAMUEL B. SWEENEY 1070 FERRY DAYTON, OREGON 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST BRANCH PALMER CREEK, a tributary of PALMER CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 7.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28502. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 19, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SMITH DLC 48, SECTION 20, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 800 FEET SOUTH AND 760 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHERLY NE CORNER, SMITH DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 14, 1987, approving Transfer Application 5930, and supersedes certificate 56077, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3546

On February 24, 1977, Samuel B. Sweeney filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 31659, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Samuel B. Sweeney, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second from West Branch of Palmer Creek for irrigation of 5.5 acres in SE2 NW2 and 2.5 acres in NE2 SW2 of Section 20, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 19, 1962.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 754 feet South and 746 feet West from the most easterly Northeast corner of DIC #48, being within the NE_2^1 SW_2^1 of said Section 20.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom, and without loss of priority to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 7.1 acres in NE¹₄ SW¹₄ and 0.9 acre in NW¹₄ SE¹₄ of Section 20, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Mr. Benjamin E. Monroe, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Semuel B. Sweeney and recorded at Page 31659, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
