CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That. Umpqua Plywood Corporation

of Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of log pond

under Permit No. 16477 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 23, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the . SW NE Section 2, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW1 NE1 NW1 SE1 NE1 SW1 Section 2 T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER No. 3553

On February 28, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Roseburg Lumber Company for changes in place of use and point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 17303, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Umpqua Plywood Corporation, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second from South Umpqua River for log pond use in SW4 NE4, NE4 SW4 and NW4 SE4 of Section 2, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 23, 1945.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 3600 feet North and 2800 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 2, being within the SW2 NE2 of said Section 2.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, change the point of diversion and use heretofore made to hereafter use water to the extent of 700 gallons per minute for the purpose of wood products manufacturing, including log storage, in the S₂ NW₄, NE₄ SW₄ and SE₄ of Section 33, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, W.M., by diversion from a point located 900 feet North and 160 feet West from the South quarter-corner of Section 33, being within the SE₄ SW₄ of said Section 33.

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Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Roseburg News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 17, 24 and 31, 1977.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 1.56 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Umpqua Plywood Corporation and recorded at Page 17303, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
