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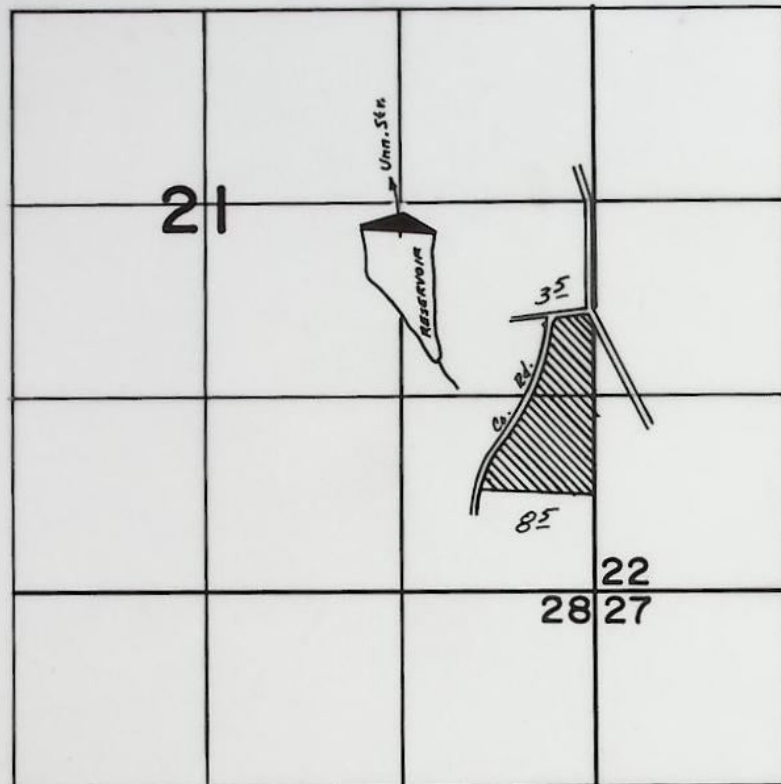

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM F. UNGER

of Rt. 2 Box 306, Cornelius, State of Oregon, 97113, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Application No. R-44039, Permit No. R-4962

a tributary of Tualatin River
irrigation of 57.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32364 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1967 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 80.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 160 feet South and 1330 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre~~, a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 80.0 acre feet per year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 43705, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on May 31, 1977, approving transfer application No. 5583, as well as to confirm a change in place of use approved by the same order. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3583

On March 14, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William F. Unger for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 43705, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of William F. Unger, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 80.0 acre feet of stored water from a reservoir for irrigation of, among other lands, 3.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 8.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 8, 1967.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 160 feet South and 1330 feet West from the East quarter-corner of Section 21, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 21.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate a certain 4.7 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 7.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 21.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to William F. Unger and recorded at Page 43705, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
