ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3535

On February 18, 1977, Frank A. and Patricia L. Jackson filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in point of appropriation under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at Page 38131, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank A. and Patricia Jackson, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second from a certain ground water aquifer for irrigation of 9.0 acres in NW4 NW4 of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 4 West; 32.0 acres in NE4 NE4, 32.2 acres in NW4 NE4, 20.0 acres in SW4 NE4 and 10.8 acres in SE4 NE4 of Section 25, Township 15 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 19, 1967.

Water for the said right is appropriated by means of three wells located as follows:

- (1) 340 feet South and 270 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 30, being within the NW1 NW1 of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 4 West, W.M.
- (2) 320 feet South and 700 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 30, being within the NW2 NW2 of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 4 West, W.M.
- (3) 350 feet South and 60 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 25, being within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 25, Township 15 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to terminate the use of the three wells above described and, without loss of priority, to appropriate the water from said aquifer for the said right by means of a well located 340 feet South and 250 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 30, being within the NW4 NW4 of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Mr. L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation from a certain ground water aquifer, described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old spoints of appropriation under the subject right, and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by that watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Frank A. and Patricia Jackson and recorded at Page 38131, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
