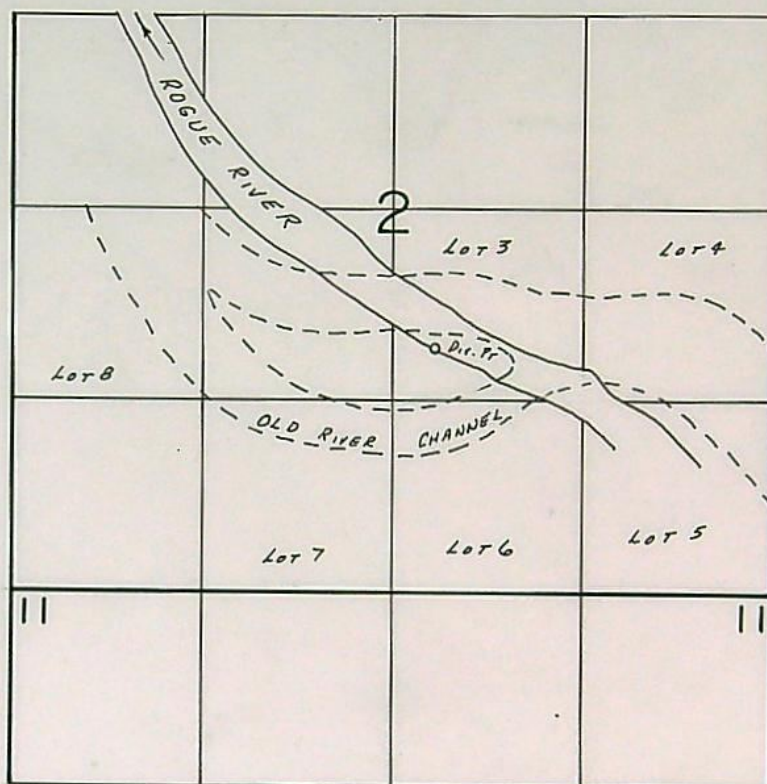

On February 3, 1977, Arlin Stafford filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 29512, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Thomas J. Murphy, describes an existing right of record for the use of not to exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of 2.8 acres in Lot 6 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 2, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 24, 1956.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 940 feet North and 330 feet East from the South quarter-corner of Section 2, being within Lot 6 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 2, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the point of diversion and to irrigate these lands from a point located 1800 feet North and 2350 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 2, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.



NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Rogue River described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Thomas J. Murphy and recorded at Page 29512, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Arlin Stafford.
