

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Research of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1891.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 3.57 cubic feet per second for irrigation from July 1st to September 15th of each year, the total quantity being limited to six acre feet per acre during each year. ORDER AMENDING ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3676

On May 8, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William H. Pledger for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered February 14, 1980, at page 4, Volume 33, Special Order Record of the Water Resources Department, approving transfer application No. 3676, was in error in not stating that the authorized point of diversion was to be retained.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that line 8, paragraph 4, page 4, be amended to read ". . . from the original point of diversion, located 100 feet North and 1500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 15 East, W.M. (Swarts Canyon Ditch), and from two additional points of diversion . . ."

ORDER

On December 4, 1979, William H. Pledger submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was allowed by Decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County, entered April 13, 1914, in the Matter of the Determination of the Realtive Rights to the Use of the Waters of Crooked River, tabulated at page 453, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in the name of S. S. Stearns, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 664, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of S. S. Stearns, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second of water from Crooked River, with a date of priority of 1891, for irrigation of a certain 4.0 acres in NW4 SE4 and 10.0 acres in SW4 SE4 of Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that" "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by certificate recorded at page 664, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

On May 8, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by William H. Pledger for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 664, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of S. S. Stearns, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 3.34 cubic feet per second from Crooked River for irrigation of 32.0 acres in NE4 NE4, 35.0 acres in SE4 NE4, 22.0 acres in NE4 SE4, 24.0 acres in NW4 SE4, 10.0 acres in SW4 SE4, 3.0 acres in SE4 SE4, Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 15 East, W.M.; 39.0 acres in NW4 NW4, 19.0 acres in SW4 NW4, Section 31; 8.0 acres in NW4 SW4, 8.0 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 16 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1891.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Swart Canyon Ditch, from a point located 100 feet North and 1500 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 1, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 0.4 acre in SW4 NW4, 18.0 acres in NW4 SW4, 26.4 acres in SW4 SW4, Section 30; 22.0 acres in NW4 NW4, 9.1 acres in SW4 NW4, Section 31, Township 15 South, Range 16 East, W.M.; 38.4 acres in NE4 NE4, 1.7 acres in SW4 NE4, 31.2 acres in SE4 NE4, 24.9 acres in NE4 SE4, 9.5 acres in NW4 SE4, 5.5 acres in SW4 SE4, 4.4 acres in SE4 SE4, Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 15 East, W.M.; and 85 acres in NE4 NW4, Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 15 East, W.M., from two points of diversion located (1) 1380 feet South and 20 feet West from the Northeast Corner, being within the SE4 NE4 and (2) 350 feet North and 1820 feet West from the Southeast Corner, being within the SW4 SE4, both in Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 15 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Central Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Crook County,

Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of December 13, 20 and 27, 1979.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1981.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 664, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
