

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second. if available at the original point of diversion, Envarr Ditch- NEXISWY SECTION 10, 7.355, R.6W, W.M., 800 feet South and 520 feet East from the SW Torner, Section 10

The certificate recorded at page 16491, Volume 13, State Record of, Water Right Certificates, in the name of A.L. Enyart and W.M Morrison, describes a right for use of not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second from Jump Off Joe Creek for irrigation of 4.0 acres in SW14 SW14, Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 6 West, WM, with a date of priority of 1893.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Envart Ditch, from a point located 800 ft. S and 520 ft. W. from the center of Sec. 10, being within NE1/4 SW1/4 of

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3735

On July 26, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by H. L. VanGordon for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16491, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of A. L. Enyart and W. M. Morrison, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second from Jump Off Joe Creek for irrigation of 4.0 acres in SW4 SW4 of Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1893.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Enyart Ditch, from a point located 800 feet South and 520 feet West from the center of Section 10, being within the NE% SW% of said Section 10.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 760 feet North and 820 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 10, being within the SW% SW% of said Section 10.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 10, 17 and 24, 1977.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diverison may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Jump Off Joe Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to A. L. Enyart and W. M. Morrision and recorded at page 16491, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water

to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
