SUBJECT: Application for change in point of diversion and place of use from Key wells 1, 3, 4, and 7 within Sections 4 and 5, Township 3 North, Range 27 East, W. M. to Key wells 1 and 2 in the SW4 SW4, Section 30, Township 4 North, Range 27 East, W. M. all within the Ordnance gravel critical ground water area.

> Applicant wishes to change point of diversion and place of use from four shallow wells which produce from the shallow gravel aquifer system in the Ordnance gravel critical ground water area, to two shallow gravel wells in Section 30, approximately 14 mile to the north. The 'moved to' wells also produce ground water from the shallow gravel aquifer system. The two wells in Section 30 have a permit (G-4878) to appropriate 8.0 cfs for the irrigation of 640 acres in the North half of said Section 4 and 5. This appropriation will be prohibited by the Ordnance critical ground water Order.

All wells involved obtain: ground water from a common water body. The use of wells 1 and 2 in Section 30 to irrigate the lands described in the subject transfer is not expected to harm existing rights.

It is recommend that the application for transfer be approved.







- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. Prior to diverting water from the new point of appropriation (well) the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation. The new proposed well has been determined to develop water from the same groundwater bearing zone as Well #3. Any modification or alterations to the new proposed well located withing the SE% NE%, Section 4, must be approved by the Watermaster. Wells #1 and 2 located within section 30 are authorized for supplemental use only on the lands described in this transfer order.

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5. The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change, without loss of priority, place of use of irrigation from a certain 40.0 acres in SW2 NE2, 38.0 acres in SE2 NE2, 9.0 acres in SW2 NW2 and 9.0 acres in SE2 NW2 of Section 4; 24.0 acres in SW2 NE2, 23.9 acres in SE2 NE2,

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510 was published in the Heppner Gazette Times, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Morrow County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 20, 27 and June 3, 1976.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster of District No. 5, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in points of diversion and place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in points of diversion and place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in points of diversion and place of use of ground water, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion, and shall not exceed 2.23 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed the change in point of diversion of water made and water applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Don C. and Jim M. Key and recorded at Page 42526, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of work and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Jim and Don Key.
