SOURCE:

Spring tributary to Rock Creek, tributary to South Yamhill River. The spring is located in the Coast Range southwest of the community of Grand Ronde.

DIVERSION POINT:

The diversion point consists of three 6" diameter underground infiltration galleries. The north and middle galleries were depositing into the system. The gate valve was closed on the south one and it is passing all water via a 6" overflow pipe to a stream channel tributary to Rock Creek.

Water is piped downhill through a 6" pipeline to a steel spring box, 8' x 12' x 8' deep with a 6" diameter overflow which drains to the stream channel. The spring box connects to a 6" diameter transmission line which delivers water to the Association's main reservoir off Fire Hall Road. The transmission line consists of both 6" and 4" sized piping, depending on the steepness of the grade, and is $6\pm$ miles long and falls 1200'± in elevation between the spring box and the main reservoir.

Along this steep downgrade there are three pressure reducing tanks which overflow to various existing roadside ditches and unnamed channels, all of which empty into Rock Creek.

The Corbett Acres Reservoir is filled by means of a booster pump station with two horizontal diffuser pumps, 85 gpm at 358', Peerless Model TH-32, 3 stage, intake and discharge 4" diameter. The motor is a Baldor 20hp, 3500rpm, 254T frame, Serial No 30755-S

The westerly end of the system, along Hebo Road, is pressurized by a pump station with a Franklin 2hp motor and a 2hp Jaccuzi Model 2 5650-5, 220 volt single phase, designed for 150' total dynamic head at 40gpm or 100' total dynamic head at 58gpm. The pump is a submersible well pump housed in an 8" ductile iron pipe lying horizontally.

USE:

The transfer changed the type of use to quasi-municipal. The Association is using this water for the uses allowed under the quasi-municipal classification, including domestic, industrial, irrigation of lawns and gardens, commercial, fire protection, stockwater and agricultural use.

The Association currently has 603 active services. There are membership holders who have a service at the road side but who have never put any water to beneficial use. These non-using members' properties were not included in the field proof survey and are not included in the area of beneficial use unless they fall in a quarter-quarter already established as a place of beneficial use by virtue of the location of actual water users.

A portion of Grand Ronde's permit boundary for this Transfer overlaps part of the Buell-Red Prairie system. Over the years, and as recently as September of 1993, Grand Ronde has sold water to Buell-Red Prairie in

sufficient quantity to supply those services lying within the boundary overlap. These include an additional 155 hook-ups for beneficial use. LIFT: As explained above, the source is elevated above the community it serves and flows by gravity to most of the services. The northeast area, known as Corbett Acres, is served by the Corbett Acres reservoir. Water is pumped by a lift station to this reservoir. The northwest area, along Hebo Road, is also assisted by a lift station to keep pressures levels up, especially during summertime periods of heavy demand. CALCULATIONS: The method used to determine the quantity of water diverted and put to beneficial use by the Association was to obtain copies of the monthly totalized figures of water sales as reported and recorded by their meter reading activities (included). The summertime readings indicate peak demand periods. For at least the last four years, Grand Ronde has routinely exceeded the 0.30 cfs allowed by this water right permit during the months of July. August and September. SURVEY TIE: The spring source was tied to the property pins which mark the corners of the Association's land ownership. The property was surveyed on February

SALEM, OREGON The spring source was tied to the property pins which mark the corners of the Association's land ownership. The property was surveyed on February 23, 1995 by Edward L. Query, PLS 1653, of Barker Surveying of Salem, Oregon. Mr. Query located the monuments at the Southeast corner and the East Quarter corner of Section 32 and set the property corners at the specified deed locations from these existing monuments. Mr. Query also provided the Association with a map of some of the physical features at the spring site. These two maps were used to measure the location of the springs in the field on April 12, 1995.

The locations of the places of use were collected in the field. Prints of 1" = 400' aerial photographs were obtained from the Polk and Yamhill County Assessor's offices. The Polk County photos were taken June 18, 1993; the Yamhill County photos are dated September of 1992. On February 22 and 24, 1995, the Grand Ronde meter reader drove their entire system with my surveyor and the places of use were located on the aerial photos. The meter reader for the Buell-Red Prairie system met with my surveyor and, with his meter list, identified on the aerial photos those places of service which lie within the Grand Ronde boundary.

T-3379 Proof Survey Page 3 The locations of the place of use were transferred from the aerial photos to USGS Quad maps. The quarter-quarter sections were identified, tabulated and transferred to the accompanying proof survey map.

REMARKS: Grand Ronde currently holds two other valid permits for an additional 0.88 cfs of water from these springs. They are Application No. 52769, Permit No. 41436 and Application No. 52770, Permit No. 41437. Therefore, the fact that they are exceeding the amount permitted by this Transfer is not a violation of their permits.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be completed under the terms and condition of Transfer No. 3379 was completed by me on the above listed dates, and the facts as contained in this report and accompanying final proof map are correct to the best of my knowledge.

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL.

This right was perfected under Permit 15608. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1943. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 6 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND 165 FEET WEST OF THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Earlier I wrote you a letter, dated May 15, 1975, concerning the amount of consumptive water that could be justified through the utilization of the water right, certification number 15613, a non consumptive right by International Paper Company for log pond and steam boiler use. At that time I felt that 50 gpm was a reasonable consumptive demand for the operation; which I have found to be far to low after a complete investigation of the log pond construction and operational program at the site.

Aerial photographs taken during peak operational activities indicate that additional ponds were utilized as settling ponds and polishing ponds. A discussion of the operational proceedure with Mr. Dick Doran of International Paper indicates that the bark and other floating debris was removed daily by surface flows to the adjoining settling ponds allowing for ready collection and disposal. A much larger pond surface area existed with these ponds than in the log pond only, greatly increasing the evaporation losses. The logs were dumped into the pond and sorted with hauling by railroad to mills elsewhere, resulting in a far larger amount of activity for splashage losses as the sheer number of logs handled through the log pond far exceeded that which would have been the case with a mill adjoining.

In conclusion, it is my opinion that the larger surface area for evaporation and the greater log dumpage and removal activities with the nature of construction of the pond would result in consumptive water demands in the nature of 120 to 150 gpm. This amount will be requested in the water right transfer we have discussed with you in the past.

The Proof Survey report and map for the above described project was submitted to your office this afternoon. I would like to request a rush processing of the certificate for this permit due to the following circumstances:

- Grand Ronde would like to transfer a portion of this area to some areas outside of their permitted boundary, primarily up Willamina Creek Road, north of the town of Willamina. They would like to have the transfer approved this fall or early winter and need the certificate in order to make the application.
- As is common in much of Polk and southwest Yamhill Counties, there is limited and poor quality ground water available. A number of the residences on this four mile stretch of Willamina Creek Road have contaminated and/or low producing wells resulting in the population purchasing or hauling water. This includes reports of bucketing water from Willamina Creek for washing clothes and flushing toilets. This is a health and safety issue that Grand Ronde is willing to help remedy.
- Unfortunately, the proposed area to be served did not get included within the water rights boundary of any nearby entity. The City of Willamina, which has the sole municipally classified rights in the area, has only raw surface water available, as their treatment plant is closer into town. The City's responsibility is first to its citizen taxpayers. If water could be provided to Willamina Creek Road as a secondary benefit to a project for their own use, then the City might be willing to consider service. There is no point for the area to try and form into an independent association or district because it cannot acquire year around surface water rights in the Willamina Creek basin and, as stated above, the ground water is unacceptable.
- Grand Ronde currently has an approved loan from the USDA Rural Economic and Community Development. Financing from the federal government no longer pays directly to the contractors as the work progresses. The owner has to obtain

> interim financing from a local bank and pay the contractors out of it. The fed pays off the interim financing when <u>all</u> construction is complete. The interest on the interim financing begins to accrue on the entire amount approved from the time the first monies are withdrawn. Grand Ronde has several different projects planned under this loan. Contracts for the construction of two reservoirs have already been awarded and construction is set to begin soon. Also included in the loan program are funds for the construction of the Willamina Creek Road waterline extension. Grand Ronde would like to be able to build this waterline extension this fall in order to minimize the time frame of their \$300,000 private loan and its accruing interest.

• I and several representatives from Grand Ronde met with Reed Marbet, Steve Brown and Michael Mattick last year. After discussing a few scenarios and possibilities, it was recommended that we proof this permit and then transfer the needed area of use.

Thank you for your immediate attention to this matter. If I can be of any assistance to you, please do not hesitate to give me a call.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3379

On March 25, 1976, International Paper Company filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in use and point of diversion from Rock Creek under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 15613, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of The Long-Bell Company, describes an existing right of record for the use of water from Rock Creek for supplying a log pond in NW1 NW1 of Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 22, 1943.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located South 43 Degrees 14 Minutes East, 1044.0 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 13, being within the NW_4^1 NW_4^1 of Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, and the said water right appurtenant thereto, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the point of diversion and the use heretofore made of the water under said right in favor of quasi-municipal use within the service area of the Grand Ronde Community Water Association, listed as follows:

and to divert 0.30 cubic foot per second at a point located 591 feet North and 32 feet West from the Southwest corner of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, W.M., for said use.

Data submitted in support of the subject application establishes that 0.30 cubic foot per second was the extent of use made under the subject right for the past many years.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510 was published in the Itemizer-Observer, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Polk County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of February 23 and March 2 and 9, 1977.

Mr. Benjamin E. Monroe, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in point of diversion and use heretofore made described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second. It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

> That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Long-Bell Lumber Company and recorded at Page 15613, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
