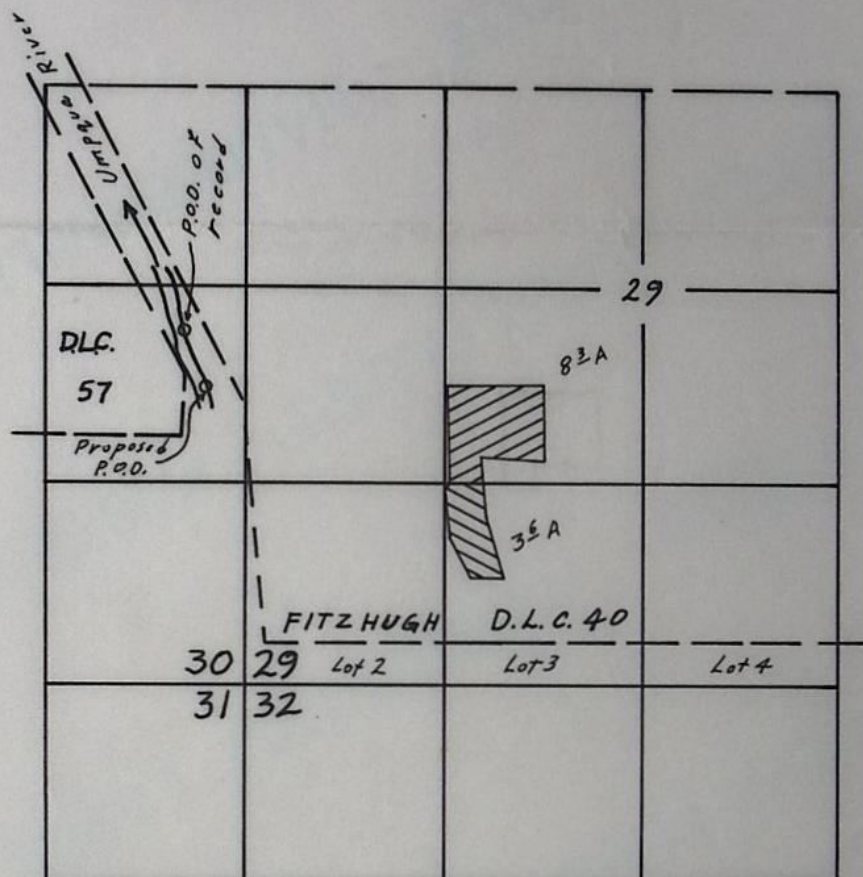

On March 31, 1976, James Oldfield filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Glenn Willis, James Oldfield, Francis Lane, Lester Walker, Arthur J. Spies and Frank Van de Walker and recorded at Page 39946, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.41 cubic foot per second of water from Umpqua River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 8.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 24, 1966. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 2330 feet North and 390 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 1980 feet North and 265 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there is no intervening diversion.

The right has been perfected under Permit 31663. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1966. The right is limited to not more than 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster of District No. 15, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Umpqua River, to wit:

From a point located 2330 feet North and 390 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 1980 feet North and 265 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 8.3 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 24, 1966, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Glenn Willis, James Oldfield, Francis Lane, Lester Walker, Arthur J. Spies and Frank Van de Walker and recorded at Page 39946, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to James Oldfield confirming the change in point of diversion.

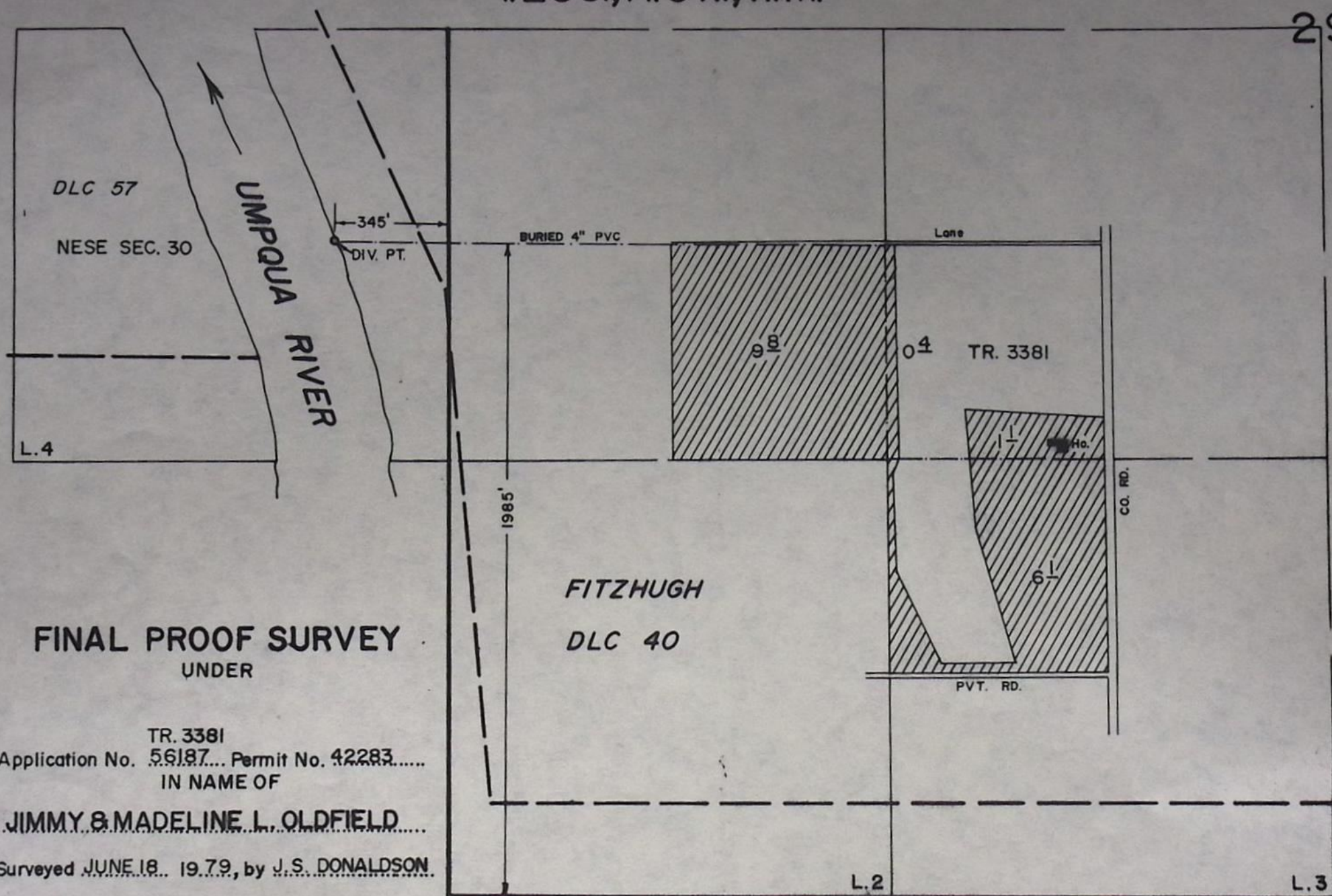
