



On July 7, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Hall and Helen Seely for approval of a change in place of use from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 8004, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of C. W. Bradford, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River for the irrigation of a certain 0.9 acre in Block 3, Woodleigh Subdivision within the NW4 SW4 of Section 14, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 12, 1924.

On July 7, 1978, Donald S. and Florence H. Smith and Hall and Helen Seely submitted affidavits that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.
