

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ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3674

On May 16, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Byron L. Rudishauser for approval of a change in point of diversion from John Day River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 21918, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Herbert Ricco, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 2.07 cubic feet per second from John Day River for irrigation of 0.5 acre in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 7.6 acres in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄; and supplemental irrigation of 12.6 acres in SW4 NE¹/₄, 16.0 acres in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 24.1 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, 1.2 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ and 21.0 acres in NW4 SE¹/₄, all in Section 13, Township 13 South, Range 32 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 25, 1949.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 480 feet North and 2050 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 18, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 18, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1100 feet North and 660 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 18, being within the SW4 NW4 of said Section 18.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 27; November 3 and 19, 1977.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved. NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Herbert Ricco and recorded at page 21918, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
