

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3849

On December 13, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glenn Orval Lewman for approval of a change in point of diversion from Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified under the provisions of the order of the Water Resources
Director, entered on November 17, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3356,
a portion of the right previously described by the certificate recorded at page
16306, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Albert
and C. O. Bigelow and George Sparlin, now exists for the appropriation of not to
exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second of water from Williams Creek, with a date of
priority of 1858, for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in NW4 SE4 and 12.0 acres
in SW4 SE4 of Section 23; and 10.0 acres in NW4 SW4 of Section 24, Township 38
South, Range 5 West, W.M., by diversion of water through the Little Williams Ditch,
from a point of diversion located 180 feet North and 400 feet West from the Center
Corner of Section 26, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 26, Township 38 South,
Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 860 feet South and 100 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 23, being within the NE4 SW4 of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of December 21 and 28, 1977; and January 4, 1978.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application

should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.87 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDEPED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

All persons interested are otified hereby that a hearing will se held at the county courthouse at Grants Pass, Oregon, on February 14, 1978, at 9:30 a.m. All objections to the proposed change, if any there are, will be heard at said time and place. Any and all objections shall be prepared in writing, one copy to be served on Glenn Orval Lewman, 17601 Williams Hwy, Williams, OR 97544 and one copy filed with the Water Resources Department, together with a \$10 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. IF NO OB-JECTIONS ARE FILED, THE AP-PLICATION MAY BE APPROV-ED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEARING. Instructions regarding the filing of a protest will be furnished by the Water Resources Department upon request.
