

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3567

On March 7, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Gordon Day for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 41610, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Frederick George Fudge and Harry A. Smith, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second from Jump-Off-Joe Creek for irrigation of 1.43 acre in SE2 SE2 of Section 32, Township 34 South, Range 5 West, W.N., and 9.6 acres in NE2 NE2 of Section 5, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, W.N., with a date of priority of October 27, 1958.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 1250 feet South and 320 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 4, being within the NW2 NW2 of Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 1120 feet South and 100 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 5, being within the NET NET of Section 5, Township 35 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOLLCOATH

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Frederick George Fudge and Harry A. Smith and recorded at Page 41610, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
