CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES HECHT 41030 KINGSTON JORDAN ROAD SCIO, OREGON 97374

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of SANTIAM RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 18.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 31142. The date of priority is DECEMBER 16, 1965. The right is limited to not more than 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3570

On March 9, 1977, Charles Hecht filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in place of use of water from North Santiam River and Detroit Reservoir pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificates of water right recorded at Pages 37456 and 37452,

Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, describe existing rights of record which include the use of not to exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second from North Santiam River for irrigation and stored water only from Detroit Reservoir for supplemental irrigation of a certain 4.7 acres in NE NW and 13.8 acres in NW NW of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with dates of priority of December 16, 1965, for North Santiam River and April 13, 1967, for stored water from Detroit Reservoir.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 2630 feet North and 1190 feet West from the North quarter-corner of Section 23, being within the NET SWT of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use therefrom to a certain 18.5 acres in NEL NEL of Section 26, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Mr. L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use of water from North Santiam River and Detroit Reservoir described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Charles Hecht and recorded at Page 37456, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water from North Santiam River to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to Charles Hecht.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of beneficial use of water from Detroit Reservoir to the extent intended under the provisions of this order such use shall be included in the confirming certificate to be issued to Kingston Irrigation Cooperative as provided by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 17, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3569.


