





U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE, DIVISION OF ENGINEERING, WATER RESOURCES BRANCH 911 NE 11TH AVE PORTLAND, OR 97232

confirms the right to use the waters of TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 129.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 22287. The date of priority is MAY 25, 1953. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 46, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; 500 FEET NORTH AND 1700 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3571

On March 9, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Alden 0. and Oleta W. Oleson for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS \$40.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 23673, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oleson Bros. describes a right for the use of not to exceed 1.11 cubic feet per second from Tualatin River for irrigation of 30.4 acres in  $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$  and 14.5 acres in  $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of Section 11; 5.5 acres in  $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ , 9.7 acres in  $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ , 24.8 acres in  $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ , 36.6 acres in  $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$  and 8.0 acres in  $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$   $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 25, 1953.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 340 feet North and 1630 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 11, being within the  $SW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$  of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the place of use and, without loss of priority, to irrigate a certain 0.4 acre in  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , 2.6 acres in  $SW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$  and 14.3 acres in  $SE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$  of Section 11; 19.9 acres in  $SE_4^1$   $NW_4^1$ , 33.1 acres in  $NE_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , 19.7 acres in  $NW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , 30.5 acres in  $SW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$ , 8.0 acres in  $SE_4^1$   $SW_4^1$  and 1.0 acres in  $NW_4^1$   $SE_4^1$  of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

NOLLOO TOV

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Oleson Bros. and recorded at Page 23673, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
