ORDER AMENDING ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3594

The Order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 1977, recorded at pages 44 and 45, Volume 29, Special Order Record, approving water right transfer application No. 3594 in the name of Wall Investment Company, was in error in paragraph 2 on page 45 in stating the location of the property to be irrigated under the subject water right. The order described the proposed place of use as being a certain 3.0 acres in NW4 of SW4 SW4 of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M., when it should have stated: "a certain 1.0 acre in NW4 SW4 (G. Terrill), 1.0 acre in NE4 SW4 (C. Loomis), and 1.0 acre in NE4 SW4 (Hoisington), Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W. M."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that paragraph 2 on page 45 of the Order of the Water Resources Director entered May 18, 1977, approving water right transfer application 3594, in the name of Wall Investment Company, be, and the same hereby is, amended to read:

"The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 1.0 acre in NW4 SW4 (G. Terrill), 1.0 acre in NE4 SW4 (C. Loomis), and 1.0 acre in NE4 SW4 (Hoisington), Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W. M."

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3594

On March 21, 1977, Wall Investment Company filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek, Deschutes River, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and Three Springs and Crescent Lake Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered August 27, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Tumalo Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River, a water right was established in the name of Tumalo Irrigation District, tabulated in the name of Wm. Kirkpatrick for the irrigation of, among other lands, 3.0 acres in NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ of Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September, 1900, as evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 26508, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

These lands also have supplemental rights evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 31412, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of water from Deschutes River, with a date of priority of 1905; certificate recorded at Page 26050, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, to the use of water from Tumalo Creek, Crater Creek, Little Crater Creek and Three Springs, with a date of priority of October 29, 1913; certificate recorded at Page 26051, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right

Certificates, to the use of the waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of April 7, 1911; and permit No. 27841 for the use of waters of Crescent Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of December 8, 1961.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water rights therefrom, without loss of priority, to a certain 3.0 acres in NW4 of SW4 SW4 of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held March 8, 1977.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water as described herein, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
