



ORDER

On January 31, 1974, Franklin M. and Helen D. Barnthouse submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 24336, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of C.G. Hedden, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second of water from Umpqua River, with a date of priority of December 29, 1952, for irrigation of 0.7 acre in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within S. Allensworth DLC 46; 7.7 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within J. Gardner DLC 51, both in Section 17; and 5.3 acres in NE1/4 NE1/4, as projected within J. Gardner DLC 51, Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 24336, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the cancellation authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered January 21, 1980 approving transfer Application 3813; and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of said order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3818

On October 3, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by George S. and Frances G. Fenn for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The affected water right is described by the certificate recorded at page 24336, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of C.G. Hedden, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second from Umpqua River, under a priority date of December 9, 1952, for irrigation of a certain 5.6 acres in NW4 SW4 and 10.8 acres in SW4 SW4 as projected within S. Allensworth D.L.C. No. 46; and 4.0 acres in SW4 SW4 as projected within J. Gardner D.L.C. No. 51, in Section 16; 1.4 acres in SE4 SE4 as projected within S. Allensworth D.L.C. No. 46; and 15.2 acres in SE4 SE4 as projected within J. Gardner D.L.C. No. 51, in Section 17; and 11.8 acres in NE4 NE4 as projected within J. Gardner D.L.C. No. 51 in Section 20, all in Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The authorized point of diversion is located 350 feet South and 25 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 20, being within the NE¼ NE¾ of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 1480 feet North and 1320 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 16, being within the NW¹₄ SW¹₄ of Section 16, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in The News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of November 19, 26 and December 3, 1979.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in

point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 24336, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
