

confirms the right to use the waters of SLAGLE CREEK, a tributary of the APPLEGATE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 10.9 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 10889. The date of priority is MAY 20, 1933. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3877

On February 8, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Harry J. and Beverly A. Youtsey for approval of a change in point of diversion from Slagle Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 43753, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Harry J. Youtsey, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second from Slagle Creek for irrigation of a certain 7.5 acres in Lot 3 (NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄) and 3.4 acres in Lot 4 (SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄) of Section 6, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 20, 1933.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 420 feet South and 970 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Davidson D.L.C. No. 39, being within Lot 2 (NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄) of Section 6, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1250 feet South and 1825 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Davidson D.L.C. No. 39, being within Lot 4 (SW4 NW4) of Section 6, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Harry J. Youtsey and recorded at page 43753, Volume 35, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
