



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3607

On March 30, 1977, Willa Mae Teel filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 21152, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of James R. Stackhouse, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from Tenmile Creek for irrigation of 1.6 acres in St NET SET of Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 25, 1944.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 300 feet

North and 1275 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 28, being within
the SE1 SE2 of said Section 28.

The applicant herein, contract buyer of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion and, without loss of priority, to divert from a point located 1270 feet North and 540 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 28, being within the SE SE SE of Section 28, Township 28 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Tenmile Creek described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

An administrative order of the Water Resources Director approving transfer application No. 3444 provides for cancelation of the certificate recorded at Page 21152, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended
under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall
be issued to the applicant herein.
