

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3609

On April 4, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Dennis and Margaret Ann Axness for changes in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 4086, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Minnie Coyle, describes a right which includes the use of water from Rock Creek with a priority date of 1882 for irrigation of 20.0 acres in W½ NW¼ SW¼ of Section 33, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.; and water from Rock Creek with a priority date of 1906 for irrigation of 20.0 acres in W½ NE¼ SE¼ of Section 32, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

Water for the said right is diverted, through Minnie Coyle Ditch, from a point located 1815 feet North and 660 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 32, being within the NE% SE% of Section 32, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

The applicants herein, contract purchasers, with written approval of the owner of the lands above described, propose to change, without loss of priority, the place of use under the 1882 priority date from the said 20 acres in the W½ NW¼ SW¼ of Section 33 to said 20 acres in the W½ NE¼ SE¼ of Section 32; and also to change, without loss of priority, the place of use under the 1906 priority date from the said 20 acres in the W½ NE¼ SE¼ of Section 32 to the said 20 acres in the W½ NW¼ SW¼ of Section 33, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

Mr. V. Kent Searles, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Minnie Coyle and recorded at page 4086, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
