

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3641

On April 25, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Mt. Angel Abbey for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 21149, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of St. Benedict's Abbey, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second from Abiqua Creek for irrigation of a certain 2.2 acres in NE½ NW½, 1.1 acres in NW½ NW½, 7.8 acres in SW½ NW½ and 15.4 acres in SE½ SW¾ of Section 14, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 25, 1943.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Walker Ditch, from a point located 725 feet North and 700 feet East from the West quarter corner of Section 24, being within the SW4 NW4 of Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 6.3 acres in NE% SW% and 20.2 acres in NW% SE% of Section 10, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Mr. Keith Palmer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.64 cubic foot per second.
