ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3975

On June 19, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Gerome Gehring for approval of a change in place of use of water from Drift Creek, purusant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

As modified in accord with the provisions of the orders of the State Engineer, entered April 23, 1969 and May 31, 1973, approving transfer applications numbered G-83 and 2787, a part of the right previously described by the certificate recorded at page 35284, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates, now exists for the use of not to exceed 0.056 cubic foot of water per second from Drift Creek for the irrigation of 4.5 acres in NW4 NE4 NW4 of Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M., with a date of priority of March 28, 1949.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 950 feet North and 520 feet East from the N¼ Corner of Section 16, being within the SW¼ SE¼ of Section 9, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The applicant herein proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.5 acres in  $SW_4$   $SE_4$  of Section 9, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Mr. Clifton R. King, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no certificate be issued confirming the change as provided by the order entered May 31, 1973 approving transfer application No. 2787, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT IN THE NAME OF OAKHILL POTATO FARMS

ORDER

On October 19, 1978, Robert G. and Gloria A. Herman submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain water rights and the real property to which the water rights are appurtenant; that they have initiated the transfer of the primary water right away from said real property and authorize the Water Resources Director to clear the supplemental right from the records of his office.

The supplemental water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 37341, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oakhill Potato Farms, and is for the use of stored water only from two reservoirs constructed under permit No. R-2992, with a priority date of August 31, 1962, for the supplemental irrigation of 2.3 acres in NE½NW½ of Section 16, Township 7 South, Range 1 West W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said supplemental water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 37341, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
