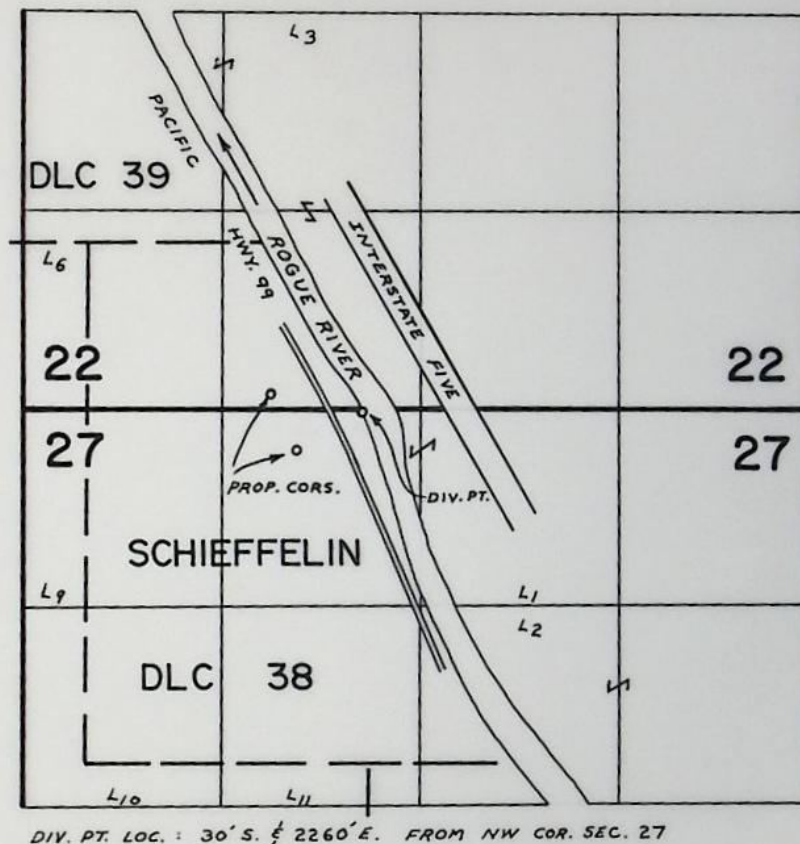

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3666

On May 9, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by James G. and Donna A. Watt for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 10956, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Gold Hill Irrigation District, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of 0.2 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 16, 1916.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Gold Hill Irrigation District Canal, from a point located North 38 degrees East, 4900 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 11, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 50 feet South and 2300 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 27, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Gold Hill Irrigation District and the proposed change in point of diversion has been approved by the Board of Directors of said District at a regular meeting on May 3, 1977.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the

Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 27, June 2 and 9, 1977.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended

under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Gold Hill Irrigation District and recorded at page 10956, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding and a certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein confirming the completed change in point of diversion authorized herein.
