

The certificate recorded at page 25711, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Prineville Land & Livestock Co., describes a right which includes the use of water from John Day River for irrigation of 4.5 acres in NE4 SE4 and 4.6 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 9; and 3.0 acres in Lot 3 (NW4 SW4) of Section 10, Township 8 South, Range 19 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1890.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 260 feet
