ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3718

On June 27, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Bruce H. Hull for approval of a change in points of diversion from Mill Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 5686, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Emma Brace, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 1/60th cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from Mill Creek for irrigation of 4.5 acres, with a date of priority of 1855, and 3.2 acres, with a date of priority of 1882, in the SW4 SE4 of Section 14, Township 1 North, Range 12 East, W.M.

Water for the said rights is diverted, through the Sandoz and Brace Ditches, from points located: (Sandoz Ditch) 290 feet South and 2850 feet West and (Brace Ditch) 880 feet South and 3762 feet West, both from the Northeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NE¹₄ NW¹₄ of Section 23, Township 1 North, Range 12 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the points of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 110 feet South and 1940 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 23, Township 1 North, Range 12 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Dalles Chronicle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wasco County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of February 7, 14 and 21, 1978.

Mr. Thomas J. Paul, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in points of diversion described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Emma Brace and recorded at page 5686, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
