ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3719

On June 29, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Dee V. Doman for approval of a change in point of appropriation from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 28655, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Henry and Ramona Fitchett, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 1.38 cubic feet per second from a certain ground water aquifer for the irrigation of a certain 35.3 acres in SW4 NE4, 35.2 acres in SE4 NE4, 1.2 acres in NE4 SE4 and 38.6 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, W.M., with a date of priority of September 6, 1955.

Water for the said right is diverted from a well located 16 feet South and 1350 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 6, being within the NE¼ SE¾ of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of appropriation therefrom, without loss of priority, to a well located 50 feet North and 1400 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 6, being within the SE4 NE4 of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, W.M.

Mr. David Beach, Hydrogeologist, Water Resources Department, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

Mr. William H. Beal, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of appropriation may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of appropriation, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of appropriation under the subject right, and shall not exceed 1.38 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of appropriation made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry and Ramona Fitchett and recorded at page 28655, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
