

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOROTHY DAVIES 11400 SIMPSON ROAD MONMOUTH, OREGON 97361

confirms the right to use the waters of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 88.6

The right has been perfected under Permit 19883. The date of priority is OCTOBER 12, 1950. The right is limited to not more than 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 14, T 9 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 390 FEET NORTH AND 1650 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3727

On July 11, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Dorothy Davies for approval of a change in point of diversion from Luckiamute River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 21186, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Louis A. Rutschman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.68 cubic foot per second from Luckiamute River for irrigation of 3.2 acres in S¼ SW¼ SE¼ of Section 14; 16.2 acres in W½ NW¼ NE¼, 6.8 acres in W½ SW¼ NE¼, 10.8 acres in E½ NE¼ NW¼ and 17.2 acres in E3/4 SE¼ NW¼ of Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 22, 1948.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 100 feet South and 700 feet East from the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 62, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The certificate recorded at page 21478, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of James Russell Oswalt, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.69 cubic foot per second from Luckiamute River for irrigation of 27.6 acres in NE¼ NE¼, 20.0 acres in E3/4 NW¼ NE¼, 22.2 acres in E3/4 SW¼ NE¼, 14.8 acres in W3/4 SE¼ NE¼, 0.4 acre in NW¼ NE¼ SE¼ and 3.6 acres in N¼ NW¼ SE¼ of Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 12, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 350 feet South and 1700 feet East from the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 62, being within the SE4 SE4 of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change from the above described points of diversion, without loss of priority, to a new, common point of diversion located 200 feet South and 1000 feet East from the Northwest Corner of D.L.C. No. 62, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. Benjamin E. Monroe, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion of water from Luckiamute River, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject rights.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended
under the provisions of this order, the certificates of water right heretofore issued
to Louis A. Rutschman and to James Russell Oswalt and recorded at pages 21186 and
21478, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu
thereof new confirming certificates of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
