

The certificate recorded at page 16981, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Walter Berg, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second from Butte Creek for irrigation of 21.6 acres in NE¼ NW¼ and 8.4 acres in NW¼ NW¼ of Section 5, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 6, 1947.

Water for the said rights is diverted from a point located 60 feet North and 950 feet West from the Southeast corner of the NW_4 NW_4 of Section 5, being within the NW_4 NW_4 of said Section 5.
