# BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON GRANT COUNTY

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ALBERT DUNN FOR APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN USE OF WATER FROM CANYON CREEK

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3744

On July 29, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Albert Dunn for a change in use heretofore made of water under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 24362, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Albert Dunn, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second from Canyon Creek for mining (chrome concentrate mill) in NW4 SE4 of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, W.M., with a date of priority of March 29, 1956.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 2147 feet North and 537 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 35, being within the NW4 SE4 of said Section 35.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the use heretofore made of 0.01 cubic foot per second, without loss of priority to irrigate 0.25 acre in NW4 SE4 of said Section 35.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 11, 18 and 25, 1977.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect

that the proposed change in use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use heretofore made may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in use heretofore made of water from Canyon Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

The applicant herein, as owner of the balance of the water right and the lands to which it is appurtenant, has submitted an affidavit that he has abandoned the balance of the said water right. Therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the water right for appropriation of not to exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second of water from Canyon Creek, with a date of priority of March 29, 1956, for mining (chrome concentrate mill) within the NW4 SE4 of Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, W.M., is hereby canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Albert Dunn and recorded at page 34362, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
