CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRED CURRIE
BOX 21-B WEAVER RD
MYRTLE CREEK, OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary to the UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-19266. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 14, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

30 S	5 W	WM	6	SE NE	39	760 FEET NORTH AND 1280 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on December 14, 1977, approving Transfer Application T-3747, and together with Certificates 59999 and 67550 the order approving T-6493, supersedes Certificate 24411. This certificate re-describes the place of use in Certificate 48649 and supersedes Certificate 48649.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3747

On August 8, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Fred Currie for approval of a change in point of diversion from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 24411, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of G. N. Weaver, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River for irrigation of 0.2 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.2 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 1.7 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.9 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February 14, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 1045 feet North and 1065 feet East from the West Quarter Corner of Section 5, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 760 feet North and 1280 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 6, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 6.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The News-Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Douglas County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 17, 24 and 31, 1977.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring device:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to G. N. Weaver and recorded at page 24411, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant therein.
