#### BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON

JACKSON COUNTY

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF PATRICK J. CUNNINGHAM FOR APPROVAL OF CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM APPLEGATE RIVER

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3753

On August 16, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Patrick J. Cunningham for changes in place of use and point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16245, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Nancy Pernoll, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second from Applegate River for irrigation of 10.0 acres in SW4 NE4, 10.0 acres in SE4 NE4 and 20.0 acres in NE4 SE4 of Section 17; 10.0 acres in NW4 SW4 of Section 16, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1886.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Cook Ditch, from a point located 1090 feet South and 220 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 21, being within the NE¼ NE¾ of Section 21, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes, without loss of priority, to sever the right from a certain 10.0 acres in SW4 NE4, 9.3 acres in SE4 NE4 and 4.0 acres in NE4 SE4 of Section 17 and to irrigate, in lieu thereof, a certain 7.0 acres in NW4 SW4 of Section 16; 10.1 acres in NE4 SE4 and 6.2 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 17, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W.M. The applicant also proposes to change the point of diversion for all of said lands to a point located 1450 feet North and 1450 feet West from the southeast corner of Section 17, being within the NW4 SE4 of said Section 17.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, of a period of three weeks in the issues of August 25, September 1 and 8, 1977.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion from Applegate River, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Nancy Pernoll and recorded at page 16245, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein,
