

, State of Oregon, 97533 of Murphy a right to the use of the waters of Panther Creek, Packers Gulch, and Iron Gulch

for the purpose of a tributary of Applegate River irrigation of 11 acres in Tract No. 1, irrigation of 0.25 acre and domestic use in Tract No. 2, and irrigation of 4.6 acres in Tract No. 3

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from July 22, 1894 for Tract No. 1, 1893 for Tract No. 2, and April 4, 1902 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1, 0.03 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2, and 0.092 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 3.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3767

On September 1, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Malcolm C. Blackhall for approval of a change in place of use from Iron Gulch, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 16281, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Thos. Leith, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.088 cubic foot per second from Iron Gulch for irrigation of a certain 4.4 acres in SE¼ SW¼ of Section 24, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 4, 1902.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Iron Creek Ditch, from a point located 1540 feet South and 1020 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 25, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.4 acres in NE¼ NW¼ of said Section 25.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Thos. Leith and recorded at page 16281, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued

covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of IRON GULCH, a tributary of APPLEGATE RIVER (FOR TRACT NO. 3), for IRRIGATION OF 2.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1902 FOR TRACT 3.

The use is limited to 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR TRACT NO. 3 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 37 S, R 6 W, W.M.; IRON CREEK DITCH - 1540 FEET SOUTH AND 1020 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 ACRE SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 ACRES SECTION 24

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.3 ACRE SECTION 25 TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 19, 1977, and together with Certificate 45298, supersedes Certificate 16281, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
