



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

STATE OF OREGON COUNTY OF MARION CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT M.L. MILLS This Is to Certify, That D. P. OBILLER P.O. Box 5305, SALEM of Route 1, Box 309 A, Ollverton, State of Oregon 97304, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek for the purpose of a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 6.8 ac. under Permit No. 19957 of th of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 29, 1950 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed -0.52 cubic foot per second -0.08 NW 4NE⁴ or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. On September 1, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by M. L. Mills for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 22684, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of L. P. Oehler, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from Abiqua Creek for irrigation of 6.8 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 30, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of August 29, 1950.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 910 feet South and 530 feet East from the Northwest corner of NE½ NE½ of Section 30, being within the NE½ NE½ of said Section 30.

The appliant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 870 feet South and 500 feet West from the Northwest corner of NE½ NE½ of Section 30, being within the NW½ NE¼ of said Section 30.

Mr. Keith Palmer, Watermaster, has filed a statment to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved. NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to L. P. Oehler and recorded at page 22684, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
