

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3769

On September 2, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Alan and Marjorie S. Cederwall for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 41614, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of George H. Collins, et. al., describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second from Williams Creek for irrigation of a certain 30.0 acres in SW4 NW4 and 22.0 acres in SE4 NW4 of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of July 15, 1913.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Dixon-Sparlin Ditch, from a point located 680 feet North and 200 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 35, being within the SW4 SW4 of Section 35, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 2600 feet South and 530 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 26, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Valley News, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 26; February 2 and 9, 1978.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved. NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervisions of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to George H.
