ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3781

On September 21, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Kenneth and Beth Nichols for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion from Beaver Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 27035, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Lawrence 0. and Erlena Gorman, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.64 cubic foot per second from Crabtree Creek for the irrigation of 17.1 acres in Lot 1 (NE¼ NE¼), 17.8 acres in Lot 2 (NW¼ NE⅓), 13.7 acres in Lot 7 (SW¼ NE⅓), 21.8 acres in SE¼ NE⅙, 7.8 acres in Lot 11 (NE⅙ SE⅙), 4.4 acres in Lot 8 (NW⅙ SE⅙) of Section 7; 10.8 acres in Lot 1 (NW⅙ NW⅙) and 1.0 acre in Lot 2 (SW¼ NW⅙) of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 2, 1951.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 100 feet South and 200 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Lot 7 (SW4 NE4), being within Lot 7 (SW4 NE4) of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, contract purchasers of the lands above described, propose to transfer the water right appurtenant to a certain 7.0 acres in Lot 1 (NE¼ NE¾), 12.2 acres in Lot 2 (NW¼ NE¾), 2.2 acres in Lot 7 (SW¾ NE¾), and 10.0 acres in SE¼ NE¾ of Section 7, without loss of priority, to a certain 17.7 acres in SE¼ NE¾, 12.4 acres in Lot 11 (NE¾ SE¾) of Section 7, 0.6 acre in Lot 2 (SW¼ NW¾), and 0.7 acre in Lot 3 (NW¼ SW¾) of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 1 West, W.M. The applicant also proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 500 feet North and 770 feet West from the Northeast Corner of D.L.C. No. 42, being within Lot 7 (SW¾ NE¾) of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 1 West, W.M. for the irrigation of these lands and the balance of the said lands, not involved in the change in place of use, being 10.1 acres in Lot 1 (NE¾ NE¾), 5.6 acres in Lot 2 (NW¾ NE¾), 11.5 acres in Lot 7 (SW¼ NE¾), 11.8 acres in SE¼ NE¾, 7.8 acres in Lot 11 (NE¾ SE¾), 4.4 acres in Lot 8

(NW4 SE4) of Section 7; 10.8 acres in Lot 1 (NW4 NW4) and 1.0 acre in Lot 2 (SW4 NW4) of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Mr. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.64 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Lawrence O. and Erlena Gorman and recorded at page 27035, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
