

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.73 cubic foot per second, measured at the head of the ditch or the point where the same leaves the natural stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year,

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

Certificate of water right issued to Heirs of Nicholas Young and recorded at page 17228, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 56.2 acres. Changes in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 21.0 acres was approved by orders of the State Engineer entered September 15, 1966 and April 6, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by orders of the State Engineer entered September 13, 1955, July 11, 1957, July 17, 1957, June 30, 1958, and October 23, 1959 and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Heirs of Nicholas Young.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3861

On January 11, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Virginia H. Lemon for approval of a change in point of diversion from Little Butte Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 39591, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Heirs of Nicholas Young, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from Little Butte Creek for irrigation of a certain 0.7 acre in SE4 SE4 of Section 4, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1899.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Young & Britt Ditch, from a point located 540 feet North and 817 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 3, being within the SW4 SW4 of Section 3, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 390 feet North and 740 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 4, being within the SE½ SE½ of said Section 4.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in The Ashland Daily Tidings, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 20 and 27 and February 3, 1978.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

. It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Heirs of Nicholas Young and recorded at page 39591, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
