

of Salem , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umoqua River

a tributary of Umpque River irrigation of 5.0 acres

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3883

On February 13, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Oregon State Highway Division for approval of a change in place of use from South Umpqua River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 22103, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oregon State Highway Commission, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second from South Umpqua River for irrigation of a certain 0.5 acre in NE¼ SW¼, 0.1 acre in SE¼ SW¼, 0.3 acre in NW¼ SE¼ and 2.1 acres in SW¼ SE¼ of Section 13; and 2.0 acres in NW¼ NE¼ of Section 24, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M., all as projected within Huntley D.L.C. No. 56, with a date of priority of February 11, 1954.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 1715 feet North and 220 feet West from the South Quarter Corner of Section 13, being within the NE¹4 SW¹4 of Section 13, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 5.0 acres in NW4 NE4 of Section 24, as projected within Huntley D.L.C. No. 56, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Oregon State Highway Commission and recorded at page 22103, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
