ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3897

On March 10, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Shirley Lee for approval of a change in point of diversion and an additional point of diversion from John Day River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 1684, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Mt. Vernon Irrigation and Power Company, describes a right which includes the use of water from John Day River for irrigation of 30.0 acres in NE¼ SW¼, 25.0 acres in NW¼ SW¼, 8.0 acres in SE¼ SW¼ and 18.0 acres in NW¼ SE¼ of Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 1, 1912.

The authorized point of diversion of record is located South 72 degrees

East, 2705 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NE NW of

Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 30 East, W.M. (Panama Ditch).

The applicant herein, contract buyer of the lands above described, proposes to change said point of diversion of record, without loss of priority, to the existing point of diversion for Panama Ditch located 520 feet South and 2080 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 30 East, W.M. The applicant also proposes to establish an additional point of diversion located 850 feet North and 1950 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 24, being within the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M., for the irrigation of lands West of Damon Creek, being 25.0 acres in NW¼ SW¼, 17.0 acres in NE¼ SW¾, and 4.5 acres in SE¼ SW¾ of Section 24, Township 13 South, Range 29 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Blue Mountain Eagle, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Grant County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 25; June 1 and 8, 1978.

Mr. Jerry Rodgers, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that

the proposed change in point of diversion may be made and the additional point of diversion established without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made and the additional point of diversion may be established without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion and additional point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion and additional point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that not less than three (3) days prior to diverting water from the additional point of diversion each irrigation season NOTICE of the intent to divert water from said additional point be given to the watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion made and the additional point of diversion established on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Mt. Vernon Irrigation and Power Company and recorded at page 1684, Volume 2, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof new certificates of water right be issued to describe that portion of the right NOT involved herein and to confirm the change authorized herein.
