



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. J. OBERSON and L. M. GOSSLER

of Stanfield , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Stanfield Drain

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of primary irrigation of 34.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 34.9 acres,

under Permit No. 18122 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1947,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.02 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 SE4. Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M. 1550 N. £ 15' W from the SE cor Sec 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3944

On April 26, 1978, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Boise Cascade Corporation Chemical Operation Division for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion from Stanfield Drain, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of J. J. Oberson and L. M. Gossler, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from Stanfield Drain for irrigation of a certain 5.8 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 18, 1947.

Water for said right is diverted from a point located 1550 feet North and 15 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 31, being within the NE4 SE4 of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use of the water right appurtenant to a certain 1.1 acres in NE¹4 SE¹4 of said Section 31, without loss of priority, to a certain 1.1 acres in W¹2 NE¹4 SE¹4 of said Section 31. The applicant herein also proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 420 feet North and 1360 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NE¹4 SE¹4 of said Section 31, being within the NE¹4 SE¹4 of Section 31, for irrigation of said 1.1 acres in W¹2 NE¹4 SE¹4 of Section 31, and the balance of said lands, not involved in the change in place of use, being 4.7 acres in NE¹4 SE¹4 of said Section 31.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the East Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Umatilla County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 31; June 7 and 14, 1978.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

ORDER

On September 29, 1978, Loy Gossler submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; and that he authorizes cancellation of said water right.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of J. J. Oberson and L. M. Gossler, and is for the use of water from Stanfield Drain, with a date of priority of November 18, 1947, for the irrigation of 2.2 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26099, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
